We follow the Solanco School District's policy for weather delays and cancellations.




SWEEP Program

The Student Weekend Eating Program (SWEEP) is in full swing and each week we are serving nearly 285 students! SWEEP serves students who qualify for free breakfast/lunch at all of the Solanco elementary schools, Martic Elementary school, and 6th grade students at Swift and Smith middle schools. If you are interested in donating to the SWEEP program, we send the students home with single-serve items for each meal that will last for both Saturday and Sunday.

In an effort to serve you more efficiently, we will need the following information **before** we can provide services:

- **Bank Statement**
- **Recent pay stub**
- **Spouse or child support verification**
- **Most recent government assistance letters** (if receiving government assistance of any kind)
- **Photo Identification**
- **Proof of current address** (i.e. electric bill)

You will be asked about changes to this information with each visit.

** Information can be dropped off, mailed, or e-mailed to the office.

* **In 2016, we helped over 600 families; 84 of them were new to us.**


*We are part of the Solanco Family Life Network and we work together with many area organizations to help Solanco families access the services/resources they need to improve their lives.
